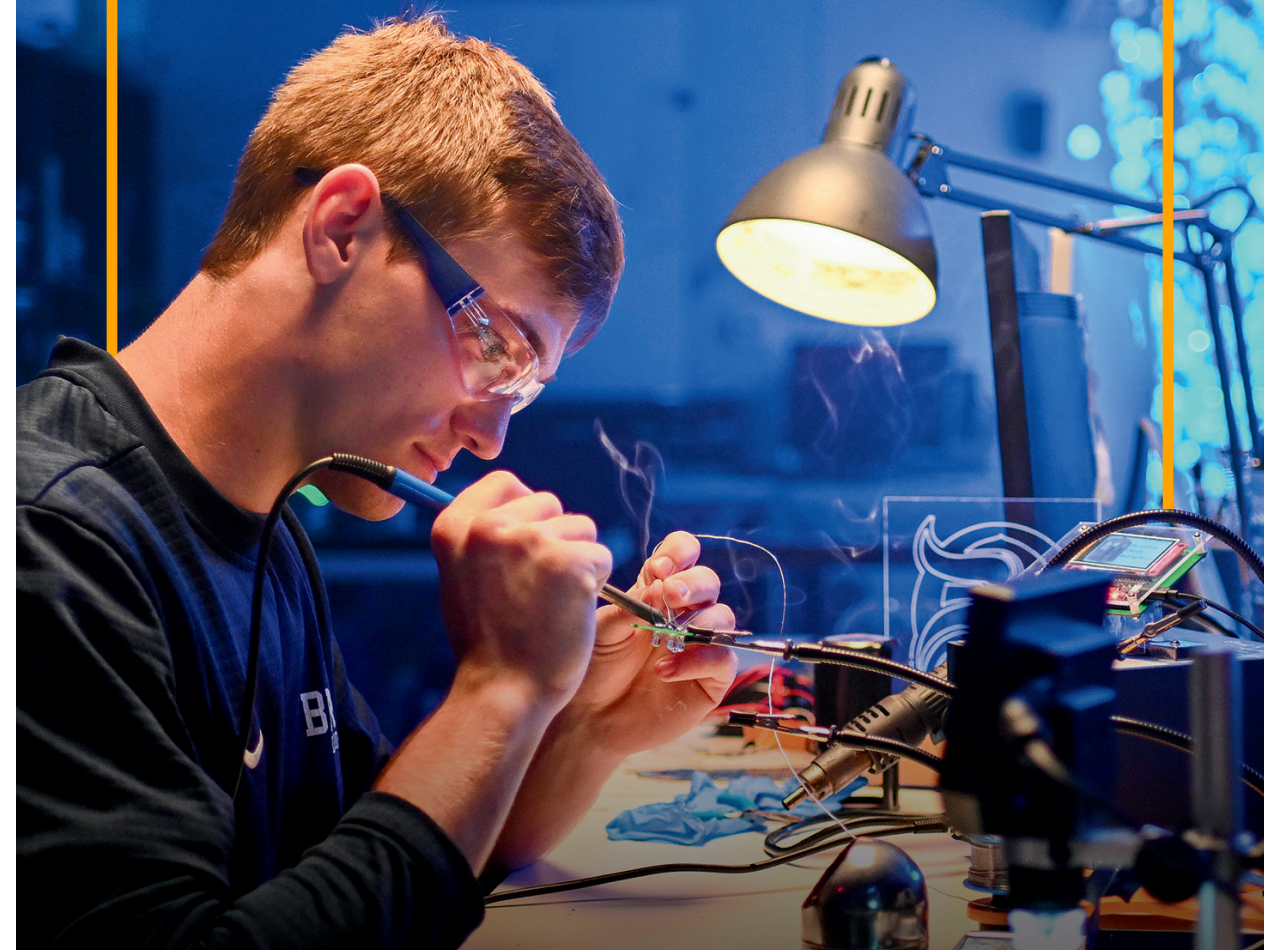

In 1902, **Martha Berry** started a school for local students. In return, she asked only that they help build and maintain it. **What Martha understood 120 years ago works equally well today:** Taking ownership of one's education increases its impact — on our students' character, on their professional readiness and on the world they will help lead.

ENROLLMENT

We are **approximately 2,200** undergrads from **49** states and **10** countries — and with **many** opinions, perspectives and points of view.

FACULTY

We are guided by **165** full-time faculty, **91%** of whom hold a Ph.D. or equivalent degree.

Mentioning our **12:1** student-to-faculty ratio is just our way of quantifying the fact that our professors **know us as individuals** and **teach us accordingly**.

FINANCIAL AID AND SCHOLARSHIPS

Yes, college is expensive (though Berry is **less so** than many other selective private colleges).

We like to think of Berry as an **investment**, a chance to get the **best possible education** (and so to live the **best possible version** of your life).

Berry helps families **manage college costs** through a combination of **merit scholarships, need-based financial aid grants** and **financing plans** that spread payments throughout the year.
